Gamestay Kale Blend

Is a kale blend of varieties, which has an advantage over a single variety the reason for this are as follows

- Disease resistance
- Weather conditions
- Soil type

We have noticed on our trials site some significant differences which has lead us to a blend that will cover most eventualities. The varieties used complement each other well providing a canopy throughout the season.

All seed will be CRUISER or COMBICOAT which is treated against flea beetle & seedling diseases. This also must be drilled.



Gamestay Octo Pussy

Is a mid season maize which has been specially selected for its qualities including

- Early vigour
- Standing ability

The seed has also been treated with both THIRAM & MESUROL



Gamestay Traditional

Is a mix of a variety of seeds containing Kale, Linseed, Sunflowers, Buckwheat, Mustard, Millet & Quinoa.

It offers a good feed & a late cover value!

Ideal for Pheasants, Partridges & Wild Birds.



Gamestay Cover Crops

Gamestay Moon Raker

Is a 3 variety maize blend with varying maturity dates & plant types.

These seeds have been selected for their

- Early vigour characteristics
- Standing ability

They have been treated by both THIRAM & MESUROL



Gamestay Yellow

Is a popular mix of maize & sunflowers, attractive to both pheasants & partridges. It contains Dwarf Sunflowers which are shorter stiff strawed hybrid.

This mixture has 2 varieties THIRAM & MESUROL which are both treated.

Key Points

- Maize & Sunflowers are a good combination
- Seed is easy to drill
- Provides feed for both game birds & song birds



Gamestay Sorghum

Is providing to be a very useful addition to the cover crop family in either a mix or on its own.

It combines well with maize & can be grown on the outside or across rows.

Sorghum is also very tolerant to many herbicides used on maize this therefore makes it an ideal partner.

But DON'T be tempted too plant to early & it also requires a good soil temperature to establish.

Weather is key with this seed.

Gamestay Gold

Has been one of our most popular mixes & is excellent value. It is designed to stand for 2 seasons. Gold has a careful blend of the following

- **Spring & Winter Triticale** (*Both Seasons*)
- **Kale** (*Both Seasons*)
- **Yellow Blossom** (*Pre-Christmas & Spring*)
- **Yellow Clover** (*Summer Cover*)

It also produces a large amount of seed & will give a tall canopy. With the bottom being open it has good access for birds & will aid in a steady flush.

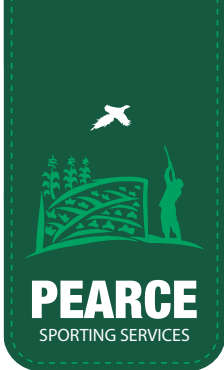


Gamestay Carbon

Carbon is a Kale x Mustard hybrid

- Amazing cover in a short period of time
- Best sown in June or July
- Excellent cover by November
- Frost tolerant
- Ideal for sowing or covering patching areas
- Can be sown into cereal stubble
- Sow at 5 kilos per hectare
